Code of Ethics

Memorandum and Articles of Association/Constitution

The Fire Protection Association Australia (FPA Australia) is a company limited by guarantee pursuant to the Corporations Act 2001 and operates under a Memorandum and Articles of Association/Constitution approved by the Australian Securities and Investment Commission (ASIC). A copy of the Memorandum and Articles of Association/Constitution, which sets out the objectives of the Association and the corporate governance rules, can be viewed online at www.fpaa.com.au/membership.

Membership Application & Approval

All applicants must submit application forms correctly completed, signed and accompanied by full payment of the appropriate fee in order to be considered for membership. The FPA Australia Board of Directors (the Board) has the sole discretion to approve or reject any membership application to the Association.

Termination & Suspension

Membership will be suspended if fees are not paid by the due date and will be terminated after 30 days of the due date.

Any member who breaches any of the following documents:

- Memorandum and Articles of Association/Constitution
- Code of Practice
- Code of Professional Conduct
- Terms & Conditions of membership

Or is guilty of any misconduct or any other action deemed inappropriate may have their membership immediately suspended or terminated by the Board of Directors. If a membership is terminated or suspended the member must immediately cease representing that they are in any way affiliated or connected with FPA Australia. Membership fees are for a period of 12 months and are non-refundable.
